Summary

For specific competitions you may want to set up your timesheet to accommodate 6 players per row. We will create 3 x groups of 2 rather than 1 group of six.

The integration of Micropower's Golf module to Electronic Tee Bookings allows you to register players into the competition straight from the timesheet. The following steps will enable you to do this for 3 groups of 2.

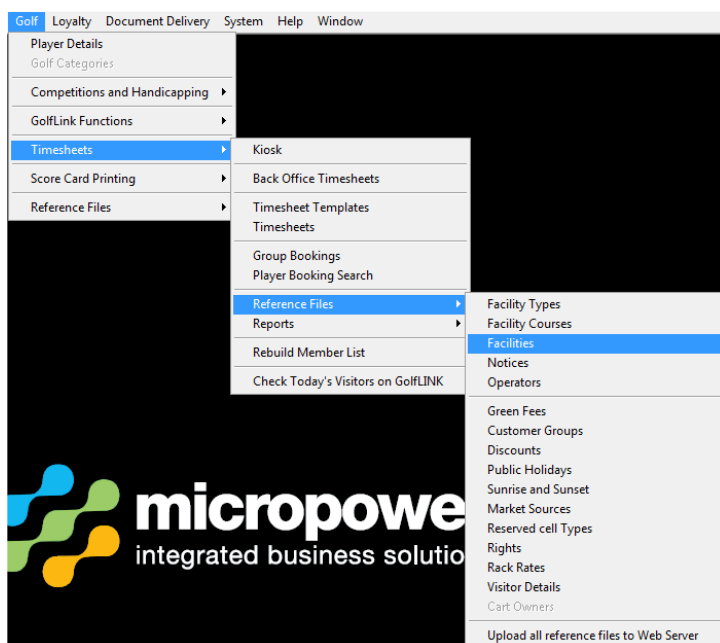
Prerequisite Knowledge

This knowledge base article assumes you have knowledge of building timesheets, timesheet templates and in conjunction competitions.

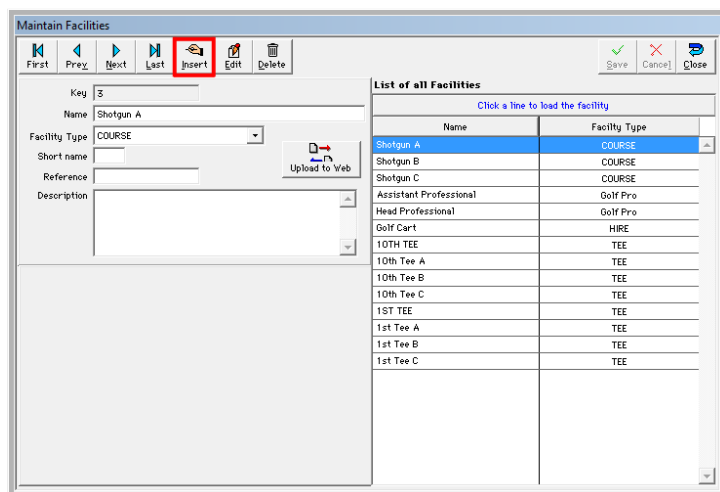
Steps required

Create Facilities

1. Go to Golf>Timesheets>Reference Files>Facilities



2. Click Insert

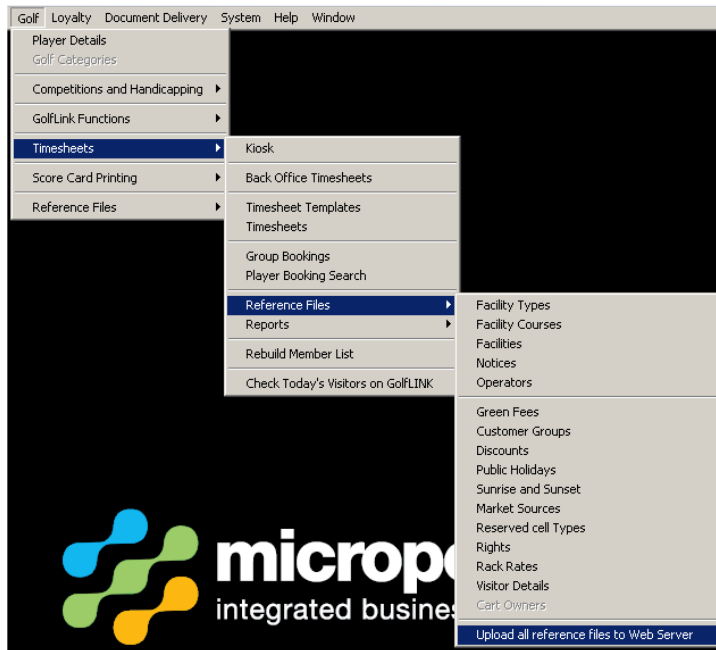


3. In the Name field type a Tee name e.g. 10TH TEE A
4. Use Facility Type as e.g. TEE
5. Use a Short Name to match e.g. 10A
6. Use a Tee Number to correspond e.g. 10
7. Select Save

8. Repeat Steps 2 to 6 to create All Tees Needed such as 1ST TEE A, 1ST TEE B, 1ST TEE C, 10TH TEE A, 10TH TEE B and 10TH TEE C.

Upload new Facilities to the web

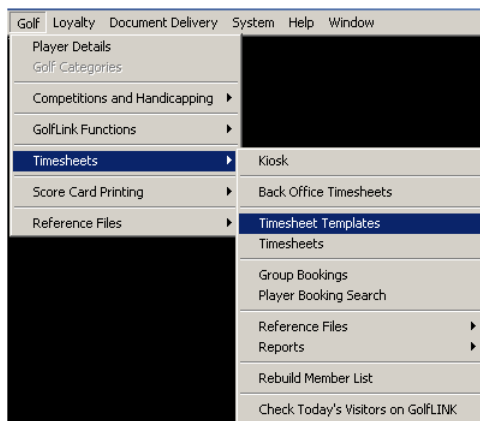
9. Go to Golf>Timesheets>Reference Files>Upload all reference files to Web Server



10. Select Yes to Upload all reference files to the Web Server?

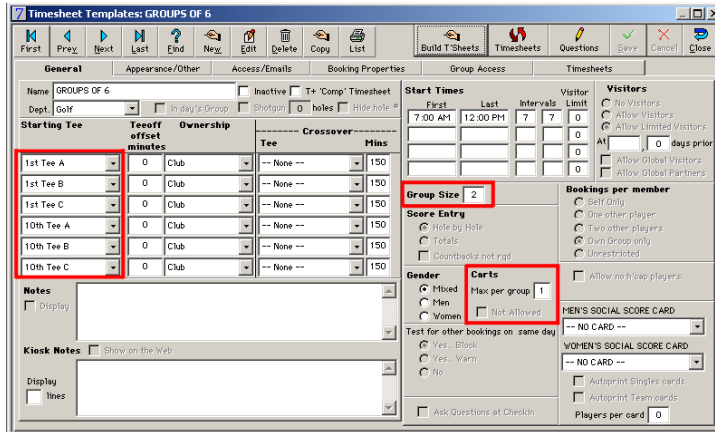
Create a new Timesheet Template

11. Go to Golf>Timesheets>Timesheet Templates

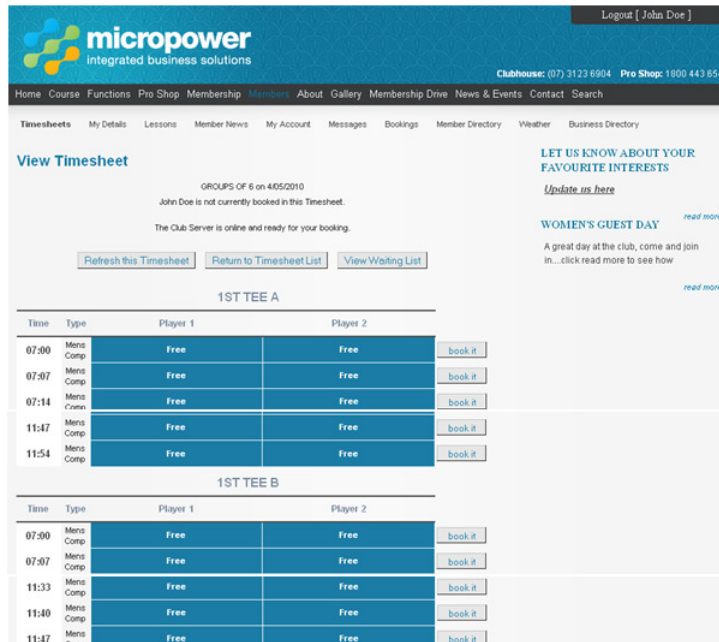


12. You will need to create a new Timesheet Template similar to the picture below.
13. Select **New**
14. Create the **Name** e.g. Groups of 6
15. Select the **Starting Tee** to be the facilities you created above. E.g. 1st Tee A, 1st Tee B, 1st Tee C, 10th Tee A, 10th Tee B, 10th Tee C
16. Select **Ownership** e.g. Club
17. Select **Mins** e.g. 150
18. Add a **Start Times** e.g. 7:00am to 12:00pm
19. Provide **Intervals** e.g. 7
20. Select **Group Size** to be 2
21. Select **Carts** to be 1

22. Select Save



- 23. Build a Timesheet from the newly created Timesheet Template (see How do I build a timesheet)
- 24. Create the Inconjunction Competition needed and attach to Corresponding Timesheet (see How do I create an inconjunction competition? | How do I attach a competition to my timesheet?)
- 25. Upload the Timesheet to Web (see How do I upload a timesheet to the web?)
- 26. The timesheet should appear on your website similar to the images below with Groups of 2



27. The backoffice timesheet should appear similar to the image below. You can now register a player as per normal via backoffice timesheets or via the player registration kiosk
